


## Capturing Art Through a New Lens


I am incredibly thankful for the generosity of the Miller Arts Scholars Program in funding and supporting my artistic endeavors. With the minigrant funding, I was able to purchase a Nikon D3500 DSLR camera, complete with an 18-55mm lens, that proved highly beneficial for photographing my artwork.

As the Nikon D3500 was surprisingly scarce at most retail stores, the search for a reliable place of purchase took longer than expected. Nonetheless, I was able to find one at a local camera shop, and I also purchased a protective camera bag and a 64 GB memory card.

This camera has allowed me to take photos of my pieces with a higher quality than my iPhone 6s camera allows. While my iPhone camera lacks the ability to capture high-resolution photos with correct colors and details, the Nikon camera has a variety of settings and adjustment capabilities to ensure high quality, professional photos that accurately portray the original pieces. I have been able to capture a majority of my art pieces to use in a digital format. As mentioned in the initial proposal, I am planning to publish a website via WordPress that will function as a digital portfolio and space for documenting my artwork. The website is almost complete and ready for publishing; I am in the process of reviewing photos and retaking them if needed, as well as adding other final details.
