


Results

When he sent me the initial photos, Jeremy advised to choose at least one commercial shot, and one dramatic/theatrical shot. I ended up choosing the four images below.

However, I reached out to Miller Arts alum Payton Moledor and she was able to add me to a Facebook group where I found a discount for Jeremy's headshot sessions.
