Distinguished Music Major Recital - Piano Accompaniment Costs

Project Proposal:

In my upcoming DMP recital, I am performing French repertoire: *Sonatine* by Henri Dutilleux, *Les folies d'espagna* by Marin Marais, *Piece Romantique* for flute, cello, and piano by Philippe Gaubert, *Concertino* by Cécile Chaminade, *Syrinx* by Claude Debussy, and *Le Merle Noir* by Olivier Messiaen. I have recruited a professional pianist, Ting-Ting Yen, as my collaborative pianist for this recital. Delivering a worthy performance in April will require continuing piano rehearsals in the Spring semester. Four out of six of these pieces are accompanied by a pianist, including the incredibly challenging *Le Merle Noir*. It is a twentieth-century piece with exceptionally intricate and demanding ensemble requirements. I am proposing funding for these rehearsals to be best prepared for my recital.

Dr. Yen and I will start rehearsing together in the last week of September, meeting once per week for an hour until the end of the Fall semester. During our rehearsals, we will integrate our respective musical parts into a cohesive musical performance. Her rate is \$60 per hour and we are planning 10 rehearsals this Fall, which will cost \$600. These rehearsals will continue in January 2024 until my Spring recital.

There are 15 weeks in the Spring semester prior to my April performance. If we stick to one rehearsal per week, that would cost an additional \$900, for an estimated total of \$1,500 in piano rehearsal fees in preparation for my DMP recital. I will pay the pianist after each weekly rehearsal, as is customary. If the committee approves this grant, it will help offset the large amount of upcoming pianist costs.

Detailed Budget:

Piano Rehearsals	\$60/hour * 10 (accounting for 10 weeks of piano rehearsals this Fall) = \$600 Requesting \$500 to offset this cost	My pianist, Ting-Ting's rate is \$60/hour. We will be meeting <i>at least</i> one time per week for one hour starting in the last week of September to the first week of December. These rehearsals will continue in the Spring to prepare for my Distinguished Major Recital.

- Piano rehearsals once per week between the weeks of September 24th and December 3rd
 - My private flute teacher, Kelly Sulick, requires that two of these rehearsals will take place during my flute lessons with her

Spring 2024

- Continue weekly piano rehearsals
 - These will likely be longer in duration as the performance approaches and may cost more than anticipated currently
 - Funding would offset these costs
- DMP Recital is on April 26th, 2024 at 8:00 PM
 - The recital will be an estimated additional \$120 for pianist fees
