Abby Milne Miller Arts Scholars Minigrant Outcome Fall 2024

Online Portfolio and Solo Show Scripts Outcomes

I was so excited to put together and publish my first professional website with my Miller Arts Scholars minigrant! I was fortunate to accidentally hit a 50% off sale when purchasing my Wix Core Premium plan, so I decided to spring for a three-year plan to save \$378 on upgrades in the long run. My Wix plan cost **\$378.00** for three years of Core and **\$38.15** for two years of my web domain and Private Registration protection, which protects my site from most domain name hijacking, identity theft, and spam emails. In total, the Wix package cost me **\$416.15** of my allocated budget. My professional website is now published and accessible at https://www.abbymilnetheatre.com/!

I organized my website into the following sections: Home, Projects, Resume, Press, and Contact. I put the most time and effort into the "Projects" tab, in which I showcased some of my recent theatrical portfolio with production photos and details about my role on each project. I would like to continue editing, refining, and adding new projects to this website over the next few years, and I hope it will speak for my past work as I seek out future freelance directing, playwriting, performing, and production opportunities. After Wix expenses, \$83.85 of my budget remained to purchase scripts for the creative component of my potential English DMP thesis. While I have yet to formally propose, I have had a preliminary conversation about my thesis idea with DMP director Caroline Rhody, who was excited about the prospect of my multi-disciplinary creative thesis.

To better stretch my remaining budget over the script purchases, I went on AbeBooks.com, which I have used in the past to purchase textbooks for UVA courses. I found used copies in "Very Good" or "Good" condition for several of my scripts, which I will order when I return to Charlottesville for a J-term course on January 2nd (I don't want to risk the books arriving at my college house while I am not in town to pick them up, and I don't have room in my suitcase to transport them from my home in California). In a recent reading for an English seminar, I encountered another one-woman show that I added to my purchase list: 2.5 *Minute Ride* by Lisa Kron, the book writer/lyricist of the *Fun Home* musical.
