However, the cameras that I currently own get extremely pixelated when I zoom in and prevent me from getting a good idea of what I'm drawing.

If this proposal is approved I will shoot more pictures and use the pictures as an alternate art form, aiding me with different projects, whether they are video, picture, or drawing based in the future.
