Therefore, I am asking that the Director of the Miller Arts Scholars consider funding my travel costs in the form of a plane ticket, local livery, and food costs. Additionally I am requesting support for the purchase of the uniforms required for this performance. These funds would give me an opportunity to gain new skills and exercise my craft in a unique way.
